SCIENTIFIC & TECHNICAL EXHIBITS ADMISSION

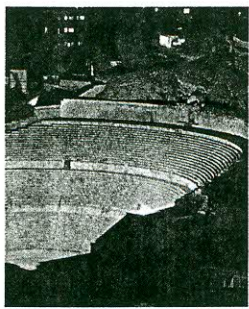
Admission to the scientific session and the exhibit hall is by badge only, you must wear the badge at all times.

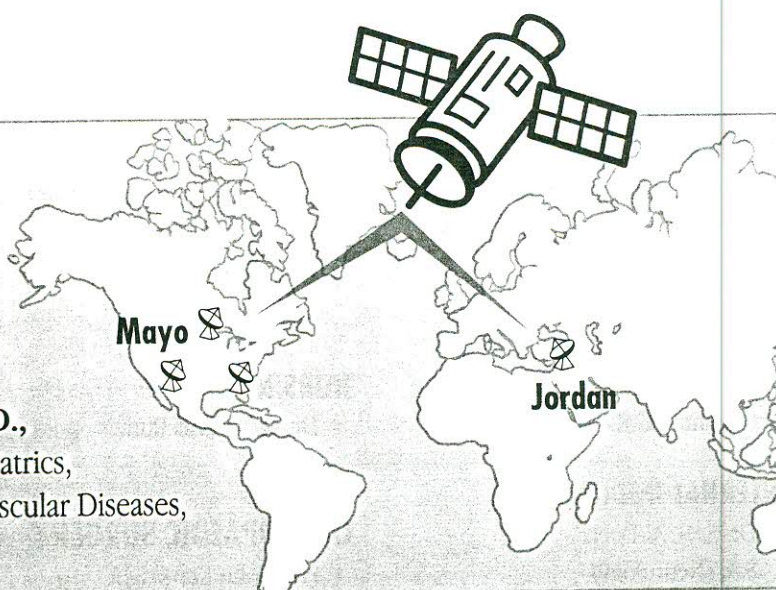
