

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS)



- **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

PALS Course is an Instructor-led, classroom-based course that enhances healthcare providers' skills in the treatment of pediatric arrest and peri-arrest patients. The goal of the PALS Course is to improve the quality of care provided to seriously ill or injured children, resulting in improved outcomes. The course uses a series of simulated pediatric emergencies to teach and reinforce the important concepts of a systematic approach to pediatric assessment, basic life support, PALS treatment algorithms, effective resuscitation and team dynamics.

- **COURSE LENGTH: Two Days.**

- **INTENDED AUDIENCE:**

For pediatricians, emergency physicians, family physicians, physician assistants, nurses, nurse practitioners, paramedics, respiratory therapists, and other healthcare providers who initiate and direct advanced life support in pediatric emergencies.
