- **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

The BLS Healthcare Provider Course is designed to provide a wide variety of healthcare professionals the ability to recognize several life-threatening emergencies. Perform CPR and use AED for adult, pediatric & infant. Use of barrier devices such as the pocket mask for rescue breathing. Deal with Choking properly.
